



AVM COVID Testing Protocol

Important note to all:

- COVID testing will be available for the Alumni Volunteers Meeting on INSEAD campus during the AVM for **daily tests**.
- Please make sure you always carry a copy of your vaccination certificate at all times.
- Daily Auto-tests

Friday 19 November	Auto-tests (results in 5m)	7h45 - 14h00
Saturday 20 November	Auto-tests (results in 5m)	7h45 - 14h00

- For those who will be traveling and require a PCR or an antigen test, we have also made these available as follows

Friday 19 November	Antigen tests (results in 15m)	7h45 - 14h00
Friday 19 November	PCR tests results in up to 24h	7h45 - 12h00
Saturday 20 November	Antigen tests (results in 15m)	7h45 - 14h00

- PCR and Antigen test results come with a QR code that can be added to the European health pass. That is not the case for auto-tests.
- You are kindly requested to take the daily auto-tests **on Friday Morning** and **on Saturday Morning** on INSEAD campus under **the Synlab tent outside CII (Library)**. Once tested, you are requested to proceed to the Amphi, and the results will be handed to you there.
- In order to locate the Synlab tent please refer to the map below.



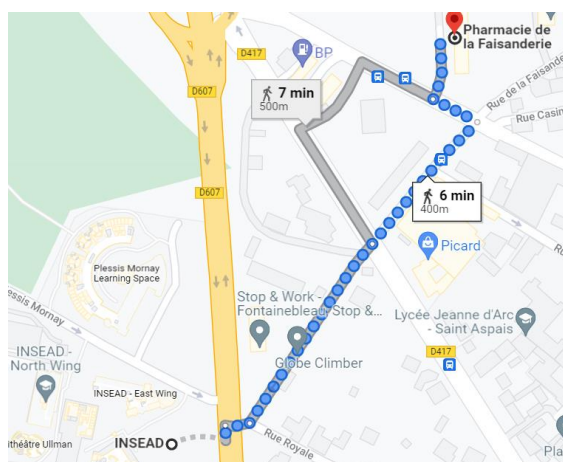
For those who require a PCR or Antigen test for travel purposes only, please note the below:

- To get an Antigen or a PCR test, participants need (if possible) to fill [this form](#) in advance, have it printed, bring it with them, and hand it over to the nurse who will do their test.
- Otherwise, participants will need to share their personal info: exact first name & last name / email address (written in CAPS) / cell phone number / date of birth (careful the exact date of birth is crucial to retrieve the tests results) with the nurses on the day of prior to getting tested. [Printed forms](#) will be available under the tent.
- No information is required in advance for auto-tests which are offered as a safety precaution.
- **Antigen** and **PCR** Results will be shared via email (from SIDEPE) on the address that has been communicated to the nurses and via text message (for French citizens only). Foreign cell phones will not get any notification.
- Participants will need to click on SIDEPE email link. It will bring them to SIDEPE web page. They will be asked to type in their exact name and exact date of birth. Once done, a passcode will be sent to their email. They will need to type it into the web page to retrieve their results.
- They will receive a [two-pager](#). **Page 1** with test results and **Page 2** “Test Certificate” with the following info in English: Exact name, date of birth, type of test, date, and time of sample.
- Participants who would like to get tested outside the on-campus slots (see slots table at the top of page 1) **at their own cost** can either:
